

## HRFE ISSUES ADDRESSED IN THE 10.1 PATCH

### **8802 – Change ADM (Administrative transaction type security)**

This will allow you to add attachments to terminated employees.

### **8831 – When an E-Class is changed from non-exempt to a D\* feeder employee class the existing work schedule on the job should be ended.**

For Employee Job Record (ERC) transactions where the e-class is changed from a C\* non-exempt employee to class to a D\* feeder employee class, the existing work schedule on the job will now be ended.

### **8847 – Change default values for Leave Category Code and Accrue Leave Indicator for Overload jobs**

For all transactions, when the Job Type is set to O (Overload), the Leave Category should default to IN (Ineligible) and the Accrue Leave Indicator will default to N (No).

### **8821 – Changes to New Hire Wizard Demographic Screen so that Chrome doesn't auto-fill**

The first name field will no longer be changed for users that have the auto-fill/auto-complete functionality turned on within their browser.

### **8814 – Change Tracker message on an Employee Group Change (EGC) transaction when the I9 cannot be found in Tracker**

When an I9 cannot be located for an EGC transaction, the new verbiage will state, “**Please contact your University HR Office before proceeding to ensure an I9 is on file**”. Employees could have a paper I9 on file as they may have been employed prior to the Tracker go-live (July 2011). Having multiple I9's for an employee can result in fines for the University.

### **8856 - Remove the "Ethnicity" field from the Bio/Demo tab and from the Print Friendly view**

This field is no longer being populated and it is causing confusion to the end users. The Ethnicity that is displayed on the Race/Ethnicity accordion is the information that is stored in Banner.
